Background (for facilitators only): Kelly James will quickly experience cardiac arrest within a clinic setting.

Supplies Required

- Mock AED (in appropriate position)
- Training Bag-valve-mask (in appropriate position)
- CPR mannikin
- sheet/cover for the mannikin

Background:

Kelly James is a 68 yo patient, seeing you for indigestion that started 30 min ago. S/he is quite worried about it. S/he has a history of COPD and and GERD.

To start the scenario:

Have an actor (may be facilitator) in a clinic chair, being interviewed by a staff member. After 30 seconds, s/he should go unresponsive.

When the actor is let down to the ground, they retrieve the CPR mannikin, which is hidden under a sheet nearby.
